

- 1. Place the under shelf on it's side on the floor.
- 2. One by one, insert each leg into the corner socket of the under shelf [Fig.1]
- 3. Use set screws to loosely attach the under shelf to the legs, approx. 7 inches from floor. [Fig.2]
- 4. Stand table upright [Fig.3]
- 5. Position the table top onto the legs, ensuring each leg is firmly located in its corresponding corner socket of the table top. [Fig.4]
- 6. Attach the table top using set screws. Ensure the table top is level and securely fixed. [Fig.5]
- 7. Securely tighten all set screws before use.

Safety Tips
